
Cougar P.R.I.D.E. Student Expectations

Cell Phone and Earbud Policy:

Cell phones and ear buds should stay in student backpacks or be placed in the pocket chart in your classroom. Students who need to call home should use the main office phone with help from main office staff. In the event that the cell phone and earbud policy is not followed appropriately, the teacher and/or administration will make every effort to reinforce the policy. If the cell phone and earbud policy is still not followed properly, cell phones and earbuds may be confiscated.

- *First offense of this policy will result in confiscation. Belongings will be returned by staff members and students will receive a warning.
- *Second offense of this policy will result in confiscation and belongings will be turned into administration.
- *Third offense of this policy will result in confiscation and a parent meeting will be scheduled with administration.
- **Please make sure your parents communicate with the main office if they need to get in contact with you during the school day. Text messages and phone calls during the day to cell phones are a major distraction to the learning environment. We appreciate your cooperation and support with this policy. Our goal is to keep you engaged in your learning and safe from unsolicited video recordings and pictures.

School Technology Policy:

All students will sign an acceptable use policy (AUP), will treat school technology with respect and use it appropriately.

Social Media Policy:

At no time should students be on social media during school hours. Taking pictures and videos during school hours is against New Haven Public School's policy.

Student Attendance Policy:

Attendance is the responsibility of both the parent and the student. Parents/Guardians must submit documentation for excused absences within two (2) days after a student returns to school.

Clinton Avenue School starts at **8:20 a.m.** and dismisses at **2:50 p.m.**Students arriving after 8:40 will be marked tardy.

Unauthorized Absences from Class/Cuts:

A cut is an unauthorized absence from a class. The following are considered a "cut":

- 1. Absence from class when in school
- 2. Arriving late to class after 15 minutes of the period
- 3. Leaving a class without permission

If a student is noted as missing classes or arriving late, an administrator will set up a meeting with both the student and parent to discuss next steps.

Code of Conduct:

The purpose of the Unified Code of Conduct is to provide school personnel, students, parents and guardians with a consistent framework of expected behaviors and responses to behaviors that are harmful or negatively affects others' ability to learn.

- Behavioral expectations are fair, age appropriate and consistent from school to school.
- Behavioral expectations protect and support the educational process and every student's right to an education.
- All students understand the behaviors expected of them.
- All students understand what will happen if they engage in behaviors that harm others and/or disrupt the learning environment.

The code of conduct applies to **EVERY** student who is under the jurisdiction of the New Haven Board of Education. It is in effect on all school property and at other places where school personnel have responsibility for students. The code also applies to students when they travel to and from school. (Refer to the Unified Code of Conduct manual.)

Bullying Policy:

Cougars do not bully other students or staff members at any time. *If you believe that you are the victim of bullying, you should immediately notify an administrator, faculty or staff member.* Bullying may include but is not limited to, acts based on: gender, ethnicity, national origin, race, sexual orientation, physical characteristics, or mental capacity.

Bullying is defined as overt acts by one or more students intended to ridicule, humiliate, or intimidate that are committed more than once against any student(s) during the school year. Bullying involves physical, social and/or psychological power over the individual(s). Bullying includes actions such as teasing, calling names, hitting, kicking, stealing, threatening as well as spreading rumors and influencing others to do these things.


Harassment Policy:
